Great Cockcrow Railway

Alcohol and Drugs Policy

General

This sets out GCR's policy for preventing risk to its activities caused by members and guests whose performance may be impaired by the results of alcohol or taking drugs.

The committee will ensure that all members and guests are made aware of the contents of this policy.

No member will

- Report or attempt to report at the railway having consumed alcohol or be under the influence of drugs.
- Be in possession of drugs whilst at the GCR.
- Consume alcohol or drugs whilst at the railway (see below).
- Take prescribed or non prescribed medication that has the potential to affect their ability to work safely without informing a committee member or the controller.

No member or guest will

- Consume alcohol on the premises during public opening times.
- Drive trains, operate equipment or be involved in the operation of the railway if they would fail the criteria to be unable to drive a motor vehicle (noting that there are two tests - over the blood alcohol limit and / or being unfit to drive due to drugs / alcohol).

Members are reminded that they need to comply with any road traffic law on departure from the site.
